Appointment of President and Chairman Effective April 1

The Board of Directors of Yokogawa Electric Corporation resolved in a meeting on January 22 to appoint Takashi Nishijima, Director and Senior Vice President, Industrial Automation Platform Business Headquarters, to the position of Representative Director and President, and to appoint Shuzo Kaihori, Representative Director and President, as Representative Director and Chairman. This transfer of responsibilities will take effect on April 1.
